## Math Practice and so much more...

We will be spending quite a bit of time working on math this year. As a school district we feel that this is an area we would like to see more growth, so we have 90 scheduled minutes a day here at Navigator Upper Elementary. Continued math practice at home for just a few minutes a day can greatly improve math scores.

This year we have already taken a math assessment that covers content areas from 4<sup>th</sup> grade. We know we forget simple steps over the summer and sometimes just need a few reminders to catch us up to speed. We are working on this remediation during our morning flex time too. In each students math journal there is a page dedicated just to "I CAN ALMOST...." Please take a moment to look at this page in your child's math journal. The highlighted areas are where they need just a bit more practice. We will be adding to this list throughout the year so please check it regularly.

How do I help with this you ask? ..... a few ways. The best resource is the Internet. If you type in the information they have highlighted you will see so many sites filled with games, and hands on activities that can support that specific area. I have also included on our Team Wonder Web Site a place you can practice your multiplication facts at <u>multiplication.com</u>

**Missing Work** - Each Friday we will be notifying and working with those who have missing assignments due to late, absences, or redo's. You can check Teacherease at anytime to find out about your child's work.

**Absent** - If your child is absent due to an illness please just focus on feeling better.
